NICK BRANNAM
DIRECTOR/
CHOREOGRAPHER

Nick was delighted to be asked to direct *Little Shop of Horrors*, his third production for BAOS Limelight following *Bugsy*

Malone and *The Addams Family*.

Little Shop of Horrors is close to his heart, being the first show he directed in May 2013 and feels honoured to oversee BAOS Limelight's first foray into The Haymarket.

Since he appeared in *Oliver!* in 2003 Nick has juggled shows with studying and working ever since. Choosing a different 'university'; a Character and Parade performer at Disneyland Paris, he declined a permanent position with them to audition for a role. He gained a BA (Hons) in Performing Arts with First Class Honors, while simultaneously directing for various societies; *The Wizard of Oz*, *Legally Blonde* (twice), *Anything Goes*, *Sister Act*, *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, and *Annie*. He also appeared in productions of *Singin' in the Rain* winning a NODA Best Actor Award and *White Christmas*.

Pursuing a career in Musical Theatre Nick continues to be busy - directing *9 to 5*, rehearsing for *42nd Street*, and is excited to be directing, *My Fair Lady*, for BAOS at The Haymarket in March 2020.

He has loved working with the enthusiastic, talented cast of *Little Shop of Horrors* and particularly AD Stephanie and MD Simon. Also, working with sister Harriet as production assistant, who is so strict he has been spared the role of rehearsal baddie.

As ever he is grateful for his family and Ryan for listening to his ideas and responding to the words 'Can you do me a favour please?'



SIMON EASTWOOD
MUSICAL
DIRECTOR

Welcome to *Little Shop of Horrors*, the show that put the writing team of Alan Menken and Howard Ashman on the

map. This was their calling card to Disney, and resulted in the fantastic scores for *The Little Mermaid*, *Beauty and the Beast* and *Aladdin*.

The first *Little Shop of Horrors* was a 1960 movie, catching the attention of 14-year-old Howard Ashman, who was quickly hooked. Twenty years later, he shared his addiction with Alan Menken and they set about writing a musical in the spirit of the original 1960s setting, incorporating soul, doo-wop and rock 'n' roll, and narrators named after girl groups of the time.

We've had a joyful summer putting together this production, with our young cast rising to greater challenges every year. The story travels to some pretty dark places, while conquering the music has required focus and dedication.

Simon trained in the Kent Youth Choirs, studied music at Southampton University and has a day-job in music education alongside a busy schedule of theatre and vocal projects. Musical director credits include: *The Addams Family*, *Les Misérables* (awarded a NODA Accolade of Musical Excellence), *Grease*, *Into the Woods*, *Evita*, *Bugsy Malone*, *Thoroughly Modern Millie*, *Hello, Dolly!*, *Calamity Jane*, *Lust!*, *Oliver!*, *Children of Eden* and *The Hunting of the Snark*. He also plays piano and keyboards in theatre bands for many adult and youth groups.


ELLA NEWBOROUGH



The Association has a membership of approximately 2000 amateur theatre groups and approximately 800 individual members staging musicals, operas, plays, concerts and pantomimes in a wide variety of venues ranging from the country's leading professional theatres to village halls. Covering a broad spectrum of age ranges NODA member societies meet the needs of all levels of both performers, whether dramatic, dance or musical, and those involved backstage, front of house or in society administration.

NODA aims:

- To give a shared voice to amateur theatre
- To help societies and individuals achieve the highest standards of best practice and performance.
- To provide leadership and advice to enable amateur theatre to tackle the challenges and opportunities of the 21st century
- To achieve these aims NODA is divided into eleven regions, each headed by a regional councillor who sits on the national council (ruling body of the Association), and supported by a network of regional representatives and officials. These volunteers are the vital link to the grass roots of the Association; the amateur theatre groups themselves and their members.
- To provide support and assistance to these volunteers the Association is administered from its office in Peterborough by a knowledgeable and friendly staff who can deal with any enquiry about amateur theatre.

Membership of NODA provides theatre groups and individuals with a wide range of benefits including access to NODA's advice service at national and regional level, as well as representation to government, access to funding agencies, direct access to rights holders and the media as well access to regional and national conferences, workshops and seminars to help share information on best practice.

NODA holds an annual residential Summer School (with bursaries available) offering training from professional tutors in a wide range of both performance and technical courses.


NODA also holds an annual national and regional programme and poster competition to encourage high standards in design.
