# **SYNOPSIS**

The show is based on the film Elf, an American Christmas comedy film that was released in November 2003. It centres on the main character Buddy, a young orphan, who mistakenly crawls into a bag of Santa's gifts as a baby and is transported to the North Pole.

There, he is adopted by and brought up by Santa's elves, unaware that he is actually a human, until his enormous size and poor toy-making abilities cause him to face the truth. Buddy subsequently learns that his biological father lives in New York City, but is on the naughty list and his half-brother doesn't even believe in Santa! With Santa's permission, Buddy sets on a journey back to New York to find father, win over his new family and spread Christmas cheer to cynical New Yorkers he meets along the way.

# Remembering Jim Welling



Our President and long-standing BATS member Jim Welling passed away in Basingstoke hospital on the evening of Friday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2021, after contracting Covid.

Jim, aged 70 was the proprietor of Edward James hair salon at the Top of Town for 45 years, and was involved with BATS for more than 50 years, graduating from young dancer to leading man in many musicals at the Haymarket, including Fagin in *Oliver!* and Professor Higgins in *My Fair Lady*, as well as several pantomime dames.

Behind the scenes Jim served on the Committee for many years and helped set up the original iteration of BATS' junior company, Next Gen. He

was a mentor to many young performers and was also a fantastic wig designer, whose creations graced the stage both locally and around the UK.

Jim was born Edward James Welling. He was the youngest of four children, born to Vera and Jack Welling, a former Mayor of Basingstoke. He grew up in Hannington and attended Hilsea College. Jim became an apprentice hairdresser at the age of 17 and set up his own business in Winchester Street in 1975. He gave generations of young stylists their first opportunity in the hairdressing industry.

He is hugely missed by his family, BATS family, former clients and wide circle of friends.

# **LOUISE TRAVIS** - Director and Choreographer

Louise originally joined BATS to play Velma in *Chicago*, which we unfortunately never got to perform due to Covid-19. However, after feeling very much welcomed by the BATS family, she joined the Committee and is putting her talents to good use as our Director and Co-choreographer for this production of *Elf-The Musical*.

Louise started in the world of theatre at a very young age, being lucky enough to assist some incredible and inspirational directors and choreographers alongside performing. After many years in local companies in her hometown of Sheffield, she was signed by an agent and moved to London aged 18, where she performed for over 20 years. Some of her favourites include Audrey in *Little shop of Horrors* (London and Off-Broadway cast), Marty in *Grease* (London cast) and Andy in *Stepping Out* (UK tour).

She has 30 years' performance and production experience in numerous pantomimes, including directing and playing Maleficent in *Sleeping Beauty* (The Spa Bridlington) and simultaneously choreographing *Snow White and The Seven Dwarfs* (The Carriageworks, Leeds) - Oh, no she didn't! Oh, yes she did!

Louise has worked as a model, choreographer and director. All of which have taken her around the world, dancing with artists including Tom Jones, STEPS and her favourite, Will Smith - however, an injury stopped her dancing professionally. Her hardest, yet most rewarding role is being Mum to four young boys; most recently twins born three years ago, which has kept her very busy! Louise is thrilled to be bringing some sparkle back to her life and hopefully yours(!) with Elf - The Musical, as it certainly gets you in the Christmas spirit. She would like to dedicate her 'Xmas song' to her inspirational late Nan.



### **ADAM BLOSSE** - Musical Director

Adam freelances under the titles of - Musical Director, MT Répétiteur, Choirmaster, Sound and Music Designer and Lecturer. He trained at the University of Surrey, achieving an MMus in Creative Practice, 1st class BMus in Creative Music Technology and a performance scholarship. His compositions placed him as finalist for Joyce Dixey and David Lovatt awards and held an audio installation for the Lightbox (Foundation). He has since clocked in over 100 shows, gaining multiple MD credits with the likes of HYT (Nuffield), KYT (Kings), PGS (Kings), Chickapow! (Riverside Arts), HMTS (Magna Carta) and PHA Pantomimes (Carriageworks, Spotlight, Connaught, Worthing Pavillion). He is currently employed as Resident MD and Lecturer for Jellicoe Theatre and Resident Pianist for the University of Winchester. His time with BATS has been immeasurable - keep singing loud for all to hear.

Luannsa has enjoyed numerous performances and roles with BATS including Pilar (*Legally Blonde - The Musical*), Urleen (*Footloose*) and Cynthia (*Priscilla Queen of the Desert*). Elf will be Luannsa's first show as co-choreographer for BATS and is excited to see her work being performed by the people she has grown up with and performed alongside. Luannsa has also worked as a choreographer for BAOS, with whom she performed and was awarded 'Best Supporting Actress' at the Curtain Call awards in 2016 for her role as Anita in *West Side Story*. Luannsa choreographed BAOS' production of *Made in Dagenham* and is currently choreographing their next production *Kinky Boots* to be performed in Spring 2022.

Luannsa began dancing at the age of seven at Footsteps Dance School, where she learnt many dance styles from ballroom and Latin to Disco and rock 'n roll. She competed for many years in regional and

nationwide dance competitions, earning trophies at the UK Championships for rock 'n roll and street dance. At 25, she retired from competing and held the title of third in the UK. Luannsa graduated from Redroofs Theatre School in 2010 and went on to work professionally in film, TV, commercials, music videos and theatre for a number of years. She has subsequently taken a step back from performing to pursue other passions and careers but has always kept one foot in the stage door. In 2018 Luannsa joined a professional dance company, The Army DC, where she learnt hip-hop, commercial and contemporary dance, which have since become some of her favourite dance styles. Luannsa is honoured to have been given the opportunity to work alongside the amazing creative team for *Elf The Musical* and can't wait to get sparklejollytwinklejingley!
